Child Care Teacher:

The Assistant Teacher helps the Teacher perform a combination of basic care and teaching duties, but the majority of their time is spent on care giving activities. It is the job of the Assistant Teacher to assist the Lead Teacher in developing programs that help children learn about trust and the ability to gain a sense of security.

Child Care Aide:

- The Child Care Aide is responsible for nurturing and caring for children. Aides carry out Child Care program duties under the supervision of the teachers and assistant teachers. In addition to attending to children's basic needs, the Aide will help the classroom teacher and assistant teacher organize activities that stimulate children's physical, emotional, intellectual, and social growth. They help children explore individual interests, develop talents and independence, build self-esteem, and learn how to get along with others. Each Aide is responsible for the children in the classroom that they are working. The classroom Aide helps the Teacher perform a combination of basic care and teaching duties, but the majority of their time is spent on care giving activities. It is the job of the Aide to assist the teachers in developing programs that help children learn about trust and the ability to gain a sense of security.
